

Hydrogen (SIBO) Breath Test

This test may take up to 3 hours.

Preparation for the Test

Two (2) Weeks prior to the test, do not have any of the following:

- Antibiotics
- Colonoscopy
- Fluoroscopy exam (such as upper GI, barium swallow, small bowel follow through)

One (1) Week prior to the test, do not take:

- Laxatives or stool softeners (Colace, milk of magnesia, ex-laxTM)
- Stool bulking agents (Metamucil or Citrucel)
- Prebiotics & probiotics (including probiotics in yogurt)

Please Note: Vitamins and medications that contain fructose flavoring, lactose fillers, fiber supplements, or Imodium could compromise the test.

24 Hours prior to the test, CONSUME ONLY THE FOLLOWING FOODS AND DRINK:

- Plain white rice, baked or broiled chicken, turkey or fish, eggs, clear chicken or beef broth, water, non-flavored black coffee or tea. Only salt and pepper may be used to flavor your food. No butter, cooking oil or sprays.
- Acid blocking medications CANNOT BE TAKEN FOR 1 DAY PRIOR TO YOUR TEST including Omeprazole/Prilosec,
 Prevacid/Lansoprazole, Dexilant, Nexium/Esomeprazole, Protonix/Pantoprazole or Aciphex/Rabeprazole.

12 Hours prior to the test, begin fasting:

- Do not eat anything until after the test is complete (plain water is ok).
- No breath mints or chewing gum.
- If you are a diabetic requiring insulin or diabetic pills, ask your primary care provider if you should adjust your morning dose.

Day of Test

Take no medications, supplements or vitamins.

2 Hours prior to the test:

- Brush your teeth (no toothpaste).
- Do not use mouthwash or denture adhesive.

1 Hour prior to the test:

- No exercise or sleeping.
- No smoking or exposure to second hand smoke.



Hydrogen (SIBO) Breath Test

Purpose of the Test

- The test is used for detecting abnormal bacteria growth within the small bowel.
- Bacterial overgrowth can cause a variety of symptoms including diarrhea, bloating, gas and abdominal cramps.

Breath Test Procedure

- Follow the instructions provided in the test kit to complete testing.
- You will be given a solution of Lactulose or Glucose to drink; you must drink the whole amount.
- Breath samples will be collected every 15-30 minutes.
- The procedure may take up to 3 hours.
- During the test, do not eat or drink (this includes hard candy, breath mints and chewing gum).
- During the test, you cannot smoke, sleep or exercise.

After the Test

- You will be able to resume your regular diet, fluids and regular medication.
- Return kit to the nearest clinic location or the lab in Federal Way as soon as possible.
- You will receive the results of your test on our portal at <u>www.washgi.com</u>. If you are not using the portal, you will receive test results by letter, phone or a follow up office visit.
